For **literacy** the Flower Room has been learning about poetry and talking about the 5 senses, spring, fruit, and emotions!

Math time has involved finishing up time (☺) and now the kids are working on writing elapsed time stories.

LEX work is coming to a close this week and next as kids finish up their final writing pieces and projects.

Forest Room

For **LEX** the kids have finished their written pieces and are also buttoning up their independent projects- all to be revealed at the potluck.



Students have also finished practicing their oral folktales and are creating their own final story to present; grammar reviews are also taking place during this **literacy** time.
