Flower Room

In **literacy** the Flower Room students are learning about point of view and examining how characters evolve throughout a story. They are also taking a look at story settings and including our prospective students in the learning who have been visiting this week!

In **math** the focus has been on learning about time and playing musical games to work on this concept.

Students have been working on their rough drafts of their projects for **LEX** and Cassandra's been incorporating yoga and meditation methods for **SEL** she learned at a recent conference!

In **LEX** the students are drafting answers to their 3 essential

questions and concluding their information - gathering phase.

For **literacy** the students have been adding to a BOT graph (behavior over time)- a strategy to incorporate systems thinking into academic curriculum. They are also starting a book study project by picking a culture and doing an in-depth study of that culture. They are also drafting their climate change poems with the help of Kate Berry!

It's the last week for gathering sap and the **math** focus will be prepping the data they've collected for analysis. Cumulative review of all the concepts from this year is ongoing as well.
